- adapted with little or no counseling needed -or- made dramatic growth
- was a past student of the month
- is a good public speaker
- medaled in at least one category (academics, the arts, athletics, service, public speaking or ambassadorship)

**QUALITIES NECESSARY  
IN A STUDENT OF THE  
YEAR NOMINEE**

1. Interests: variety of clubs & hobbies
2. Activity: should be active in broad spectrum of sports, arts, etc.
3. Service: Should be regular in worship of God and in service to others.
4. Personable: Sociable, liked by many, adaptable to change without complaint. Polite, neat, & a good public speaker.
5. Intellect: Must be honor student
6. Discipline: must be high achiever in a regularly practiced endeavor.
7. Responsible: Helps w/chores, clean, orderly, organized.

**STUDENT OF THE MONTH**

- honor roll at least once
- participant in at least one competitive activity
- community volunteer and/or church service and/or school service and/or service to host family
- participant in at least one non-competitive extracurricular activity
- nomination from at least one teacher and/or coach, host parents, school counselor, PEACE rep

**ATHLETIC MEDALIST**

- team leader in at least one competitive sport (group or individual)
- probably helped team to reach conference, district, league, or state level competition
- evidence of frequent publicity and/or nomination from coach(s)

**ARTS MEDALIST**

- leader in at least one performing or creative arts endeavor - drama, music, painting, drawing, writing, etc.
- may have won or shared in some sort of regional or or state level competition or had their work displayed
- evidence of publicity and/or nomination from coach, conductor, or teacher for their artistry

**ACADEMICS MEDALIST**

- GPA entire school year in high nineties
- honor roll every marking period and carrying serious academic course load
- one or more recognitions such as National Honor Society, Scholarship, Science Fair finalist or comparable

**SERVICE MEDALIST**

- community volunteer and/or church service and/or school service and/or service to host family
- involved continuously throughout year for above activities
- and with recognition/nomination for same

**PUBLIC SPEAKING MEDALIST**

- community and/or church and/or school speaking engagements to talk about their country
- recognized achievement in speaking roll such as model UN Rep, comedy or poetic reading, debating
- and with recognition/nomination for same

**AMBASSADOR-AT-LARGE**

- recognized widely in school and community as cheerful ambassador of good will to all students and adults. high achievement of academics or skills categories not relevant to this award. Personifies "the mission".
